Purpose

This document contains excerpts of 3C Corrosion Control Company's Environmental Policy, translated from Swedish into English. The statement, as well as all internal governing procedures, written routines and records, is incorporated in 3C's quality management system, authored in the native language of the personnel. Environmental policy and procedures are developed in close relation to ISO 14001 and the European Waste Framework Directive, 2008/98/EC.

General statement

3C Corrosion Control Company is a highly specialised company with extensive know-how in cathodic corrosion protection systems and with a strong international focus. We are a professional and environmentally conscious organisation which acknowledges the impact that our operations may potentially have on the environment.

Objectives

The organisation fully commits to:

- protect the environment
- determine compliance obligations and ensure operations are completed in accordance with them
- continually improve the management system to enhance environmental performance
- evaluate fulfilment of the compliance obligations
- correct non-conformities
- allocate suitable and sufficient resources which enable the company to achieve its environmental aims and objectives
- prevent pollution, reduce waste and ensure that, wherever practical, measures are implemented to protect and preserve natural habitats, flora and fauna
- consider the effects that our operations may have on the local community
- take action to eliminate or reduce, as far as practicable, any potentially adverse environmental impacts
- complete internal audits and following a path of continuous improvement
- ensure effective and expedient incident control, investigation and reporting

Organization and responsibilities

CEO has overall and final responsibility. QA is responsible for operations and self-inspection. Workhouse personnel are responsible of reporting environmental issues and non-conformities in accordance with procedure 106-46-MI-A1 "Routine for Chemicals and Waste Management".

Audits

Self-inspection is carried out together with auditing the quality management system, at least annually. Third party environmental inspections are made by local authorities at least every fifth year.
